WHO WE ARE

The Marin County Office of Education's School to Career (STC) Partnership provides Marin County students with direct support to engage in work-based learning (WBL) experience and career exploration, leading to high-demand, high-wage jobs.

WHY SPONSOR AN INTERN?

STUDENT INTERNSHIPS

Provide a paid or unpaid experiential work-based learning opportunity. School to Career liaisons help students get "work ready" with a resume, cover letter, and mock interview.

FALL, SPRING AND SUMMER INTERNSHIPS

The Fall and Spring Internship Programs are an 8-week intensive career exploration opportunity requiring students to spend 6 to 9 hours per week on the worksite with a mentor for a minimum of 54 hours. Fall internships begin in early October, and Spring internships begin in early February. The internship program is recommended for juniors and seniors. Elective academic credit is available.

Classroom Guest Speaker
